<p>What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?</p>	<p>Our most important field of activity is universities. We open stands by participating in the activities of universities. In addition, information seminars and documentary screenings are held. In these seminars, especially the experts of the subject are brought together with the students within the scope of these activities. During the pandemic process, our activities continued online.</p> <p>With Zoom meetings and the Google Meet application, conference activities were held with more than one young person at the same time and discussion activities were realized. In these events, developments on the agenda, innovations, exemplary projects and policies produced by states were discussed. From time to time, guests from abroad were also invited to this event.</p> <p>Our group was established as a special sub-working group for the Erasmus Plus project. Our members in this group have previously taken part in Erasmus Plus projects in Hungary, Spain and France and gained experience during the implementation phase of the projects.</p> <p>Together with our members, we organized a project writing camp in KA152 and KA153 types. We included young people who</p>

	<p>participated in the project writing camp, which was open to the local public, among our members.</p> <p>Public Relations training was given to university students by our members on the role of Digital Intelligence. This training aimed to determine the role of digital intelligence on university students and public relations students who will be public relations experts of the future.</p> <p>A seminar called "What are Communication Skills?" was organized by our members. Local people and university students were invited to the seminar. In the seminar, topics such as "What is the Importance of Communication Skills? How to Develop Effective Communication Skills? What is the Communication Skills Scale?, What is the Communication Skills Inventory? and What are Social Communication Skills?" were analyzed. In the seminar we held, it was aimed to develop the skills of local people and university students. in terms of communication, listening, good use of diction, good use of voice, and correct management of body language.</p> <p>conference, a presentation was made to support Digital Transformation. With this conference, local people were informed about the process of creating new opportunities and values by using digital transformation digital technologies, strengthening social structures with digital technologies, and making them more efficient. Our members also invited their families to this conference. All these activities have provided us with experiences in order to successfully manage the works we will carry out within the scope of our project, provide resource information to the activities, and ensure that the participants take active responsibility in the activities. In addition, these activities will help our members to come together and communicate with more people, stay in touch with decision-makers, easily involve local people in our project work, or establish healthy communication processes with our stakeholders.</p> <p>Finally, one of our projects named "Digital immigrants' battle for survival" with the reference number 2022-1-SK02-KA153-YOU-000053679 was approved by the Slovak National Agency.</p>
